**** Spending money is not included in this estimate. Students will also pay to purchase a bus pass each month through their school (\$55/month 2016/17 rate). International students registered in 30-level Diploma courses are required to pay \$50.00 per Diploma exam (whether they are writing for the first time or rewriting an exam). Students from countries who require their final report cards to be legalized/revalidated in Canada must submit a request form and pay a \$150 CAD service fee at the end of their study period. International student tuition fees do not exceed the costs of programming as per the Alberta School Act.
